Transcend (Somnetics)


The Transcend is one of the world's smallest CPAP units and is perfect for those who travel. Covered by a 3 year warranty, the machines are available in two models:


- *Transcend EZEX* – a fixed pressure CPAP with EZEX (pressure relief feature, same as flex).
- *Transcend Auto* – an auto machine that provides pressure relief with EZEX.

All machines record compliance, AHI and leak information, with the auto model also recording 90% pressure. Patients are provided with the Somnetics software, so are able to email compliance information to the pharmacy. This is particularly useful if they are travelling or unable to come in. The machine stores 13 months of data and has the option to run on an overnight (P4) or multi-night (P8) battery. Further information and videos can be found at www.mytranscend.com.au.


Please note: The P4 battery is not recommended for pressures of 15cm or greater, and the P8 for pressures of 19cm or greater.

To set up the device, plug in the power cord and connect the machine to the computer via the USB cord. Open the Somnetics software located on your computer desktop and follow these steps.



Ramp

The Ramp feature allows the patient to start at a lower pressure than their therapy pressure.

Over a defined period of time, the pressure will be gradually increased until it reaches therapy pressure.

If you choose to enable Ramp, you will be given an opportunity to set the ramp starting pressure and duration on the next screen.
